# Family Learning Weeks 9th—20th November

### **Early Years**

#### **Pippins**

We have been busy in Pippins over the last few weeks finding out about autumn and sharing some traditional stories. Working with parents is very important in Pippins and we make sure that there is time everyday for parents to talk to their child's key worker about what they have been doing in the session, their learning and development.

#### Year 1

We had a carousel of activities based around the mathematics we have been learning in class and children were able to demonstrate to parents how to use Numicon to support counting, addition and subtraction. Parents joined in creating shape pictures with their children and practised naming the shapes they used. We welcomed everyone joining in our counting in 5's and 10's and sang the times tables. The children had opportunities to work with their parents, showing them number formation and counting on with the help of playing board games and everyone loved making space rocket pictures using elastic bands on geo-boards.

A fun morning had by all with some productive, active mathematics.
