Dear Parents and Carers

There are a number of matters that we need to bring to your attention in a short newsletter this week, the full newsletter will be distributed next week.

Well done to all Year 6 staff and pupils, a gruelling week but we got there!

Complaints and conciliation

School has a clear policy on resolving potential issues with regard to your child **or** how school is operating. The full complaints policy is listed on our website. Parents are respectfully requested to follow protocol and use informal resolution as the preferred way forward. If parents have an issue they would like to discuss these are the protocols that we follow;

Informal stage

If the complaint is regarding their child, parents should make an appointment with the class teacher so that the complaint can be dealt with quickly and efficiently.

- Parents should avoid approaching teachers at the beginning of the day or at the end of the day before children are dismissed. This is so that the teacher can give the parent their full attention as when children are present the teacher's main function is to teach.
- Class teachers will willingly see parents after the close of school providing training or other appointments are not conflicting with the parent's wishes to see them. If this is the case, the next available appointment time can be agreed quickly. Parents can refer the matter to the Phase Leader in the class teacher's absence.
- If having seen the class teacher or the Team Leader the parent is not satisfied with the outcome, they are asked to make an appointment to see the Assistant Headteacher.
- If after seeing the Assistant Headteacher the parent is still not satisfied with the outcome they are then asked to make an appointment to see the Deputy Headteacher.
- If after seeing the Deputy Headteacher and a satisfactory resolution is not agreed, parents should seek an appointment with the Headteacher. If after seeing the Headteacher they are still not satisfied parents should put their complaint in writing and address it to the Headteacher. The complaint will then be dealt with according to the formal complaints procedure listed on our website.

We hope that this clarifies approaches on school site. In addition, Mrs Webb our Pupil Inclusion Parent Support Service (PIPSS) Manager and qualified Social Worker, will always be available to see parents who have concerns about their child or family welfare issues.
